

2017-2018 Early Enrollment Rules of the Road

Who is Eligible?

Any certified or classified public school employee who has not been a member in the past.

When Can They Join?

Early Enrollment dates are from April 1, 2017 through July 31, 2017.

What is the Cost?

There is no cost for the months of 4/1/17 through 8/31/17, dues payments begin with the first payroll of the 2017-2018 school year, with a membership year that begins on September 1, 2017 and extends through August 31, 2018, or the first day of school of their 2017-2018 school year, whichever comes first.

What are the Benefits of Early Enrollment Membership?

Access to NEA educator employment liability insurance program and select benefits offered by NEA Member Benefits.

How Are Membership Application Forms Processed?

All enrollments must be completed on an official NEA-New Mexico Early Enrollment 2017-2018 application form.

All completed forms are to be sent to the region office for your local association. The applications will be entered into the NEA-NM database and submitted to the payroll clerk for your district by the Region Associate at the appropriate time to meet the deadline for the first payroll deduction of the 2017-2018 school year.

Any applications that are submitted by the local may accidentally be entered into the current membership year rather than the appropriate 2017-2018 school year payroll roster.

All Early Enrollment membership applications must be maintained by NEA-New Mexico for fifteen (15) years as required by NEA.
